

Cutting

Background (BG)

- 3- 3 7/8 Squares cut in half once diagonally
- 2- 4 1/4 Squares cut in half twice diagonally
- 4- 2 7/8 Squares cut in half once diagonally

Dark (A)

- 2- 4 1/4 Squares cut in half twice diagonally

Dark (B)

- 3- 3 7/8 Squares cut in half once diagonally

Medium (C)

- 4- 3 7/8 Squares cut in half once diagonally

Medium (D)

- 4- 2 7/8 Squares cut in half once diagonally

Light (F)

- 1- 4 3/4

Light (G)

- 4- 1 1/2x4 1/2
- 4- 1 1/2x6 1/2

Piecing

Piece the (BG) 4 1/4 triangles and the (A) 4 1/4 triangles together and make 8 half square triangles. Piece those together into pinwheels like in photo.

Next make half square triangles out of the (B) and (BG) 3 3/8.

Piece together a 12 1/2 inch un-fished block using the units above and fabrics (C) (F)

So it looks like photo above.

Using (BG) 2 7/8 triangles and (D) make 8 half square triangles, make these into two pinwheels. Frame each one with (G) using the 1 1/2x4 1/2 on opposite sides followed by 1 1/2x6 1/2.

Put the two pinwheel units together and add them to you 12 1/2 block.

Finished unit should measure 18 1/2 x 12 1/2

Border

To make the border you will need a total of 36 6 1/2 pinwheels.

For one

Cut 2- 3 7/8 background in half once diagonally

And 2 of a medium or dark. The scrappier the better.

Make 4 half square triangles and piece them into a pinwheel.
