



Cutting.

Light

10 -2 7/8" Cut once in half

Dark

10 -2 7/8" Cut once in half

Medium 1

4 -4 1/2" Squares

Medium 2

6 -3 7/8" Cut once in half

Medium 3

2 -3 7/8" Cut once in half

Background

2 -3 7/8" Cut once in half

8 -3 1/2" Squares

Start Block 3 by making 5 -4 1/2" pinwheels. Using 10 light and 10 dark 2 7/8" squares cut in half once. Make your half square triangles and then into the pinwheels.

Next make the 9 patch using the 5 pinwheels and 4 -4 1/2" squares of a medium.

For the corner triangles start with the 3 7/8" triangles of background and 3rd medium. Make 4 half square triangles. Finish the triangles using the 3 1/2" background squares and the 2nd medium 3 7/8" triangles. Stitch them to the 9 patch. You now have your first 18" finished square.
